

## 2020 IRRIGATION TURN-OFF

The irrigation season for agricultural customers using pressurized water from the Oliver Water System (rural and urban) ends on:

**Tuesday, October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020**

Crews will begin turning off services at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 6<sup>th</sup>. If your service has not been turned off by Friday, October 30<sup>th</sup>, please contact the Public Works Department at 250-485-6213. In any case, no agricultural irrigation is permitted from the pressurized water system after October 6<sup>th</sup>, unless late water has been purchased in advance.

Growers on the pressurized system, who require irrigation beyond October 6<sup>th</sup>, need to apply to the Public Works Department no later than Tuesday, October 6<sup>th</sup>, in order to avoid additional turn-on fees. The cost for late water is \$1.70 per acre, per day, and is available until Monday, October 26, 2020.

**To facilitate grape growers who pump their own water from the irrigation canal, the Town will again maintain flows to a later date. Canal diversion will cease on October 27, 2019.**
